Organisational Foresight

Most organisations that suffered major disasters believed they were safe.

The warning signs were there — documented, known in fragments, by people working inside the organisation. What failed was not the information. What failed was the organisation's capacity to see it. Organisational Foresight teaches senior leaders, executives and board members how to develop that capacity before harm occurs.

LEGAL CONTEXT

Post-disaster inquiries from Pike River to Deepwater Horizon found that boards and senior management had access to information that should have prompted action. Under Australian WHS law, officers have a personal duty of due diligence that includes knowing and acting on the safety performance of their organisation.
