Organisational Foresight

Mining has produced some of the world's worst disasters. They all share a common pattern.

From Pike River to Samarco, major mining disasters were not random. They were preceded by a recognisable pattern — signals visible but not acted on, tolerances that normalised deviation, leadership detached from operational reality. Organisational Foresight gives leaders the framework to interrupt that pattern before harm occurs.

LEGAL CONTEXT

The Pike River Royal Commission found the board and senior management were inadequately informed of safety performance. Australian mining regulators strengthened requirements for senior management engagement with leading indicators in response. Officers carry a personal duty of due diligence extending to all aspects of their organisation's safety performance.
